

Minutes of the Trimley St Martin Parish Council Annual Meeting held on 25th August 2015 at 7.30pm in The Memorial Hall, Trimley St Martin

Public Session

The Chairman read the report from County Councillor Goodwin.

1. To Receive Apologies for Absence

Apologies for absence had been received from Councillors Cowan and Eve.

2. To Receive Declarations of Interests

No Councillors declared any interests in matters on the agenda.

3. To Receive and Determine Requests for Dispensations

There were no requests from Councillors for dispensations enabling them to speak, or speak and vote, on matters on which they have a pecuniary interest.

4. To Approve the Minutes of the Meeting Held 18th August 2015

The minutes of the meeting held 18th August 2015 were agreed and signed as a true record.

5. To Receive a Presentation from Bidwells Regarding land off High Road, Trimley St Martin

The Chairman reported that Bidwells had now indicated they would not be able to attend before the October meeting at the earliest to give a presentation regarding land off High Road, Trimley St Martin.

6. To Consider and Comment on the Following Planning Applications:-

The Council considered the applications and agreed to comment as follows:-

a) DC/15/2293/FUL – erection of a pre-fabricated timber granny annexe for ancillary residential use – 67 Mill Lane

There should be a condition requiring the occupation of the granny annex to be only in conjunction with the occupation of the existing dwelling.

b) DC/15/2795/FUL – Removal of existing single height pitched roof extension and flat roofed extension. To be replaced with double height extensions from south to north and single height pitched roof extensions coming off to both the east and west – 17 Old Kirton Road
No objection.

7. To Note and Comment on the Consultation on Traffic Regulation Orders for Mill Lane and High Road

The Council agreed to object to the proposals for Traffic Regulation Orders for Mill Lane and High Road in their current form and to ask that the restrictions be extended as follows:-

a) in Mill Lane – to the boundary of the Methodist Church car parking area (both sides of the road)

b) in High Road – to the boundary between 346 and 344 High Road.

8. To Approve the Amended Accounts and Agree the Revised Section 1 of the Annual Return

The Council approved the amended Accounts and agreed the revised Section 1 of the Annual Return, which was duly signed.

9. Closure

The meeting was closed at 8.12 p.m.
